LIRN provides information resources from the following sources:

Gale/InfoTrac: Academic OneFile, Business and Company Resource Center with PROMT and Newsletters, Computer Database, Custom Newspapers (contains full text articles from 128 newspapers), Expanded Academic ASAP, Gale Virtual Reference Library, General Business File ASAP, Health and Wellness Resource Center and Alternative Health Module, Health Reference Center Academic, InfoTrac Criminal Justice Collection, InfoTrac LegalTrac, InfoTrac OneFile, Literature Resource Center, Newsletters ASAP, Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center, and the Student Resource Center-Gold.

ProQuest: ABI/INFORM Dateline, ABI/INFORM Global, ABI/INFORM Trade & Industry, Evidence-Based Resources from the Joanna Briggs Institute, Health & Medical Complete, National Newspaper Abstracts, Nursing & Allied Health Source, ProQuest Psychology Journals, and ProQuest Research Library (with 16 subject modules).

eLibrary: Selected periodicals, reference books, maps, pictures, newspapers from around the world, and transcripts of news and public affairs broadcasts.

Bowker: Books in Print, Books in Print For Patrons, and RCLweb.

LIRNSearch: LIRNSearch is a federated search engine that allows you to simultaneously search all of the LIRN sources or to search by subject groups, or as individual databases.
